

**Rules and Regulations
Colorado City Cemetery – Park Addition #04**

By the authority of the Colorado City Council the following rules and regulations are required and are applied to Park Addition #04.

1. Use of a concrete vault or equivalent.
2. Absolutely no curbing, rock metal, etc. or any kind of miscellaneous ground cover will be allowed.
3. There shall be no planting or placing of trees, shrubbery, flowers, plants, ornamental decorations, statues, etc. of any kind in or on any grave.
4. Donations of trees, plants or shrubs may be made to the City Cemetery, but will be planted in a designated area supervised by the City.
5. All headstone markers must be placed on a slab of concrete. The backside of the marker must be placed even with the curbing.
6. No kind of mausoleums etc. is allowed in any section of Park Addition 04.
7. There shall be only ONE marker to each gravesite exception unless it is a husband/wife marker.
8. No foot marker is allowed on any grave for any reason unless it is a military marker (veteran). This marker must be placed at the opposite end of the headstone and the foot marker must be the size or within the perimeters to the curbing. It cannot be any larger than the curbing.
9. The headstone markers are to be placed at the west end of the grave that are odd numbered rows and on the east side of the grave that are even numbered rows.
10. All markers cannot be any larger than three and half feet in width (unless it is covering a two person grave i.e. husband/wife, and that is subject to no wider than four and half feet) and no higher than three feet tall. Th is height includes the base and any extension such as a cross, angel, etc.
11. **Flowers may be placed on the grave but only in the space contained in the headstone or base.**
12. Any company, funeral home, or person setting a headstone will have to notify the city before placement is made. If this is not done, the headstone will be rest at the owner's expense.

The Cemetery Management is hereby empowered to enforce all Rules and Regulations contained herein, and to exclude from the Cemetery any person violating same.

The Cemetery Management further reserves the right to adopt additional rules and regulations or to amend, alter, or repeal any rule, regulation, or part thereof at any time with the approval of the City Council. Sufficient notice will be given by said Management of any rule change that would create expense or inconvenience to the lot owners.

Should any marker, headstone, or display become unsightly, dilapidated, or a safety hazard to visitors, the Cemetery Management shall have the right to immediately correct the condition, or to remove same, at the expense of the lot owner.
